EU-JAPAN EPA – THE BIGGEST AGREEMENT EVER -> FULL FOCUS ON THE ROLL-OUT

- **EIF:** 1 February 2019. Year 2: 1 April 2019.
- **Economic Agreement:** Tariffs will be removed or reduced, TRQ, GI's (e.g. Feta, Danablu), services, public procurement etc.
- **Partnership:** High Level Visits. Regulatory cooperation, Joint Committee 10 April in Tokyo, Sub-Committees for standards and practices. E.g. Food Additives. SPS. NTM. Agricultural Dialogue on 20 July 2019.
- Together with the SPA EU-Japan it **covers almost everything** except DSB.
- The trade estimated to **increase** up to 150% (fully implemented).
- **First mover** advantages. USA left behind.
- Challenges:
Rules of Origin, JAPAN CUSTOMS / Administration, TRQ lottery, SG's, HS-classification
 - **REX**-system (quite simple and easy) *or*
 - **Importers Knowledge** (Japanese exemption). Documentation?

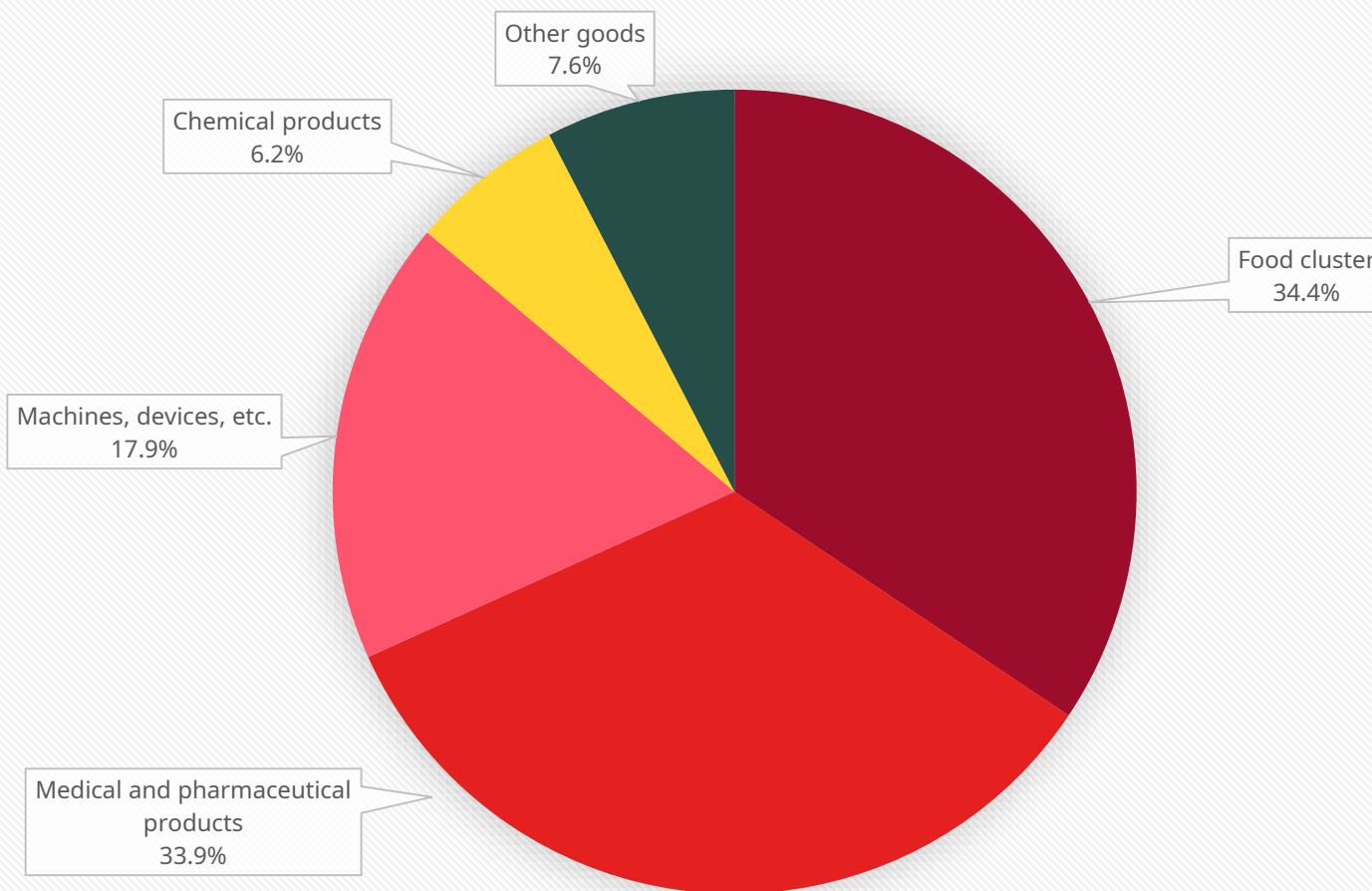

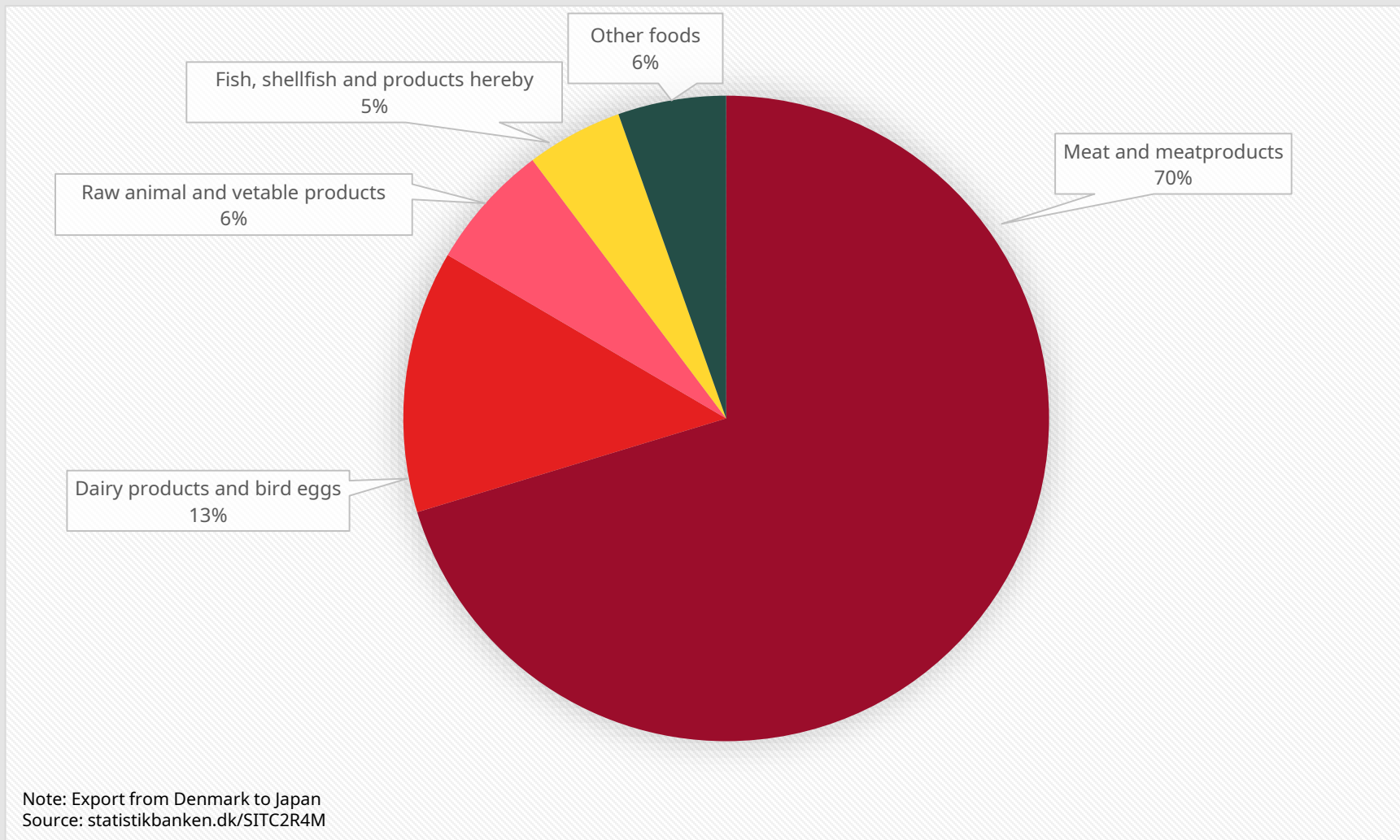

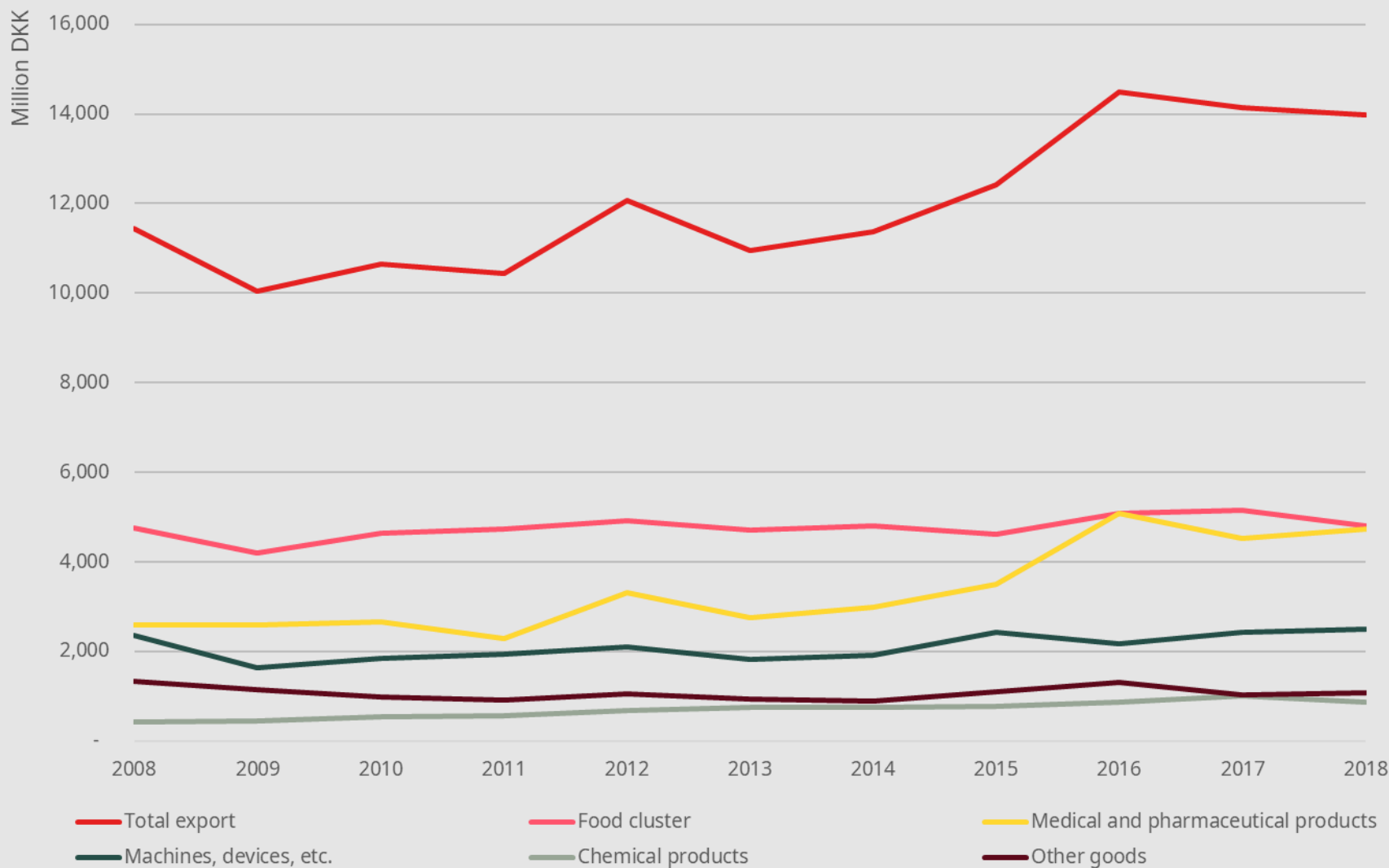
