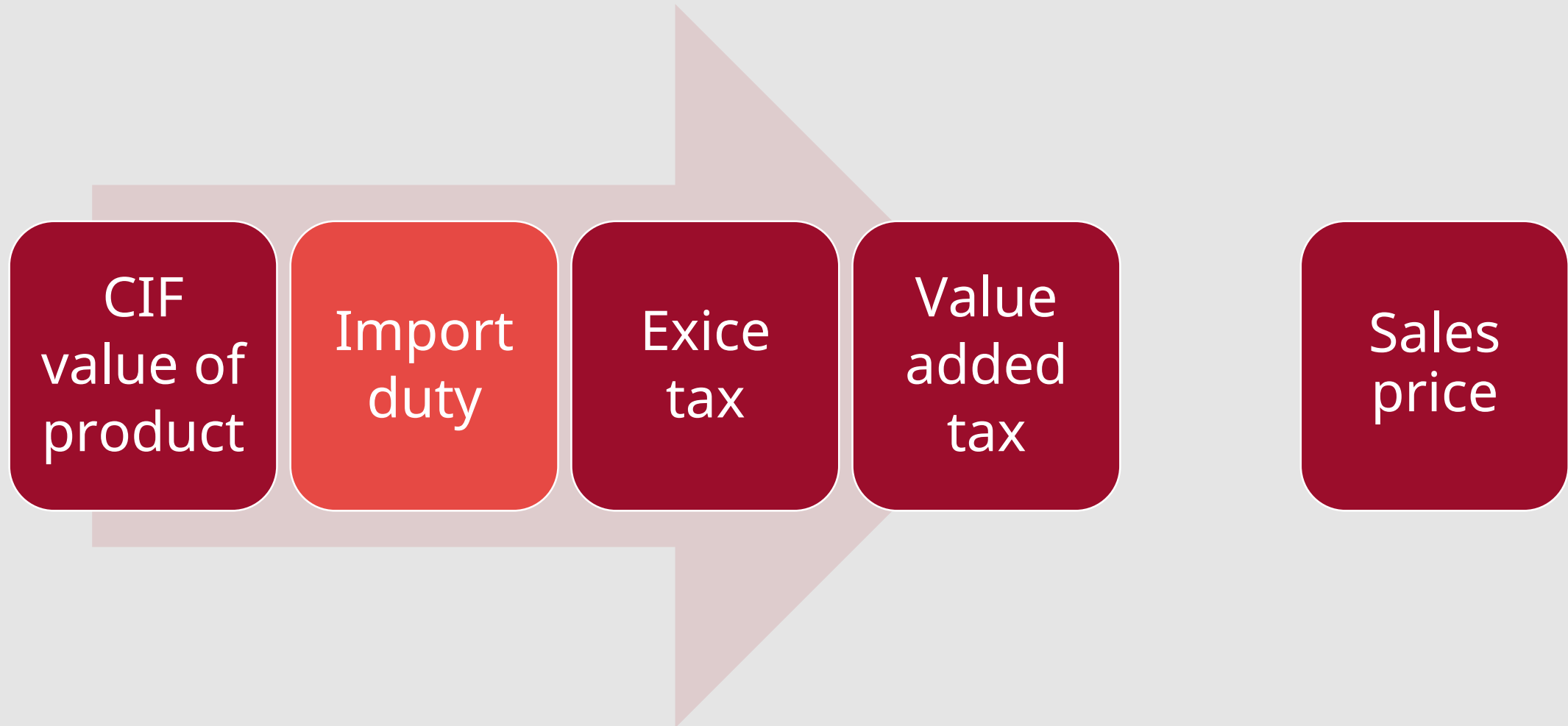

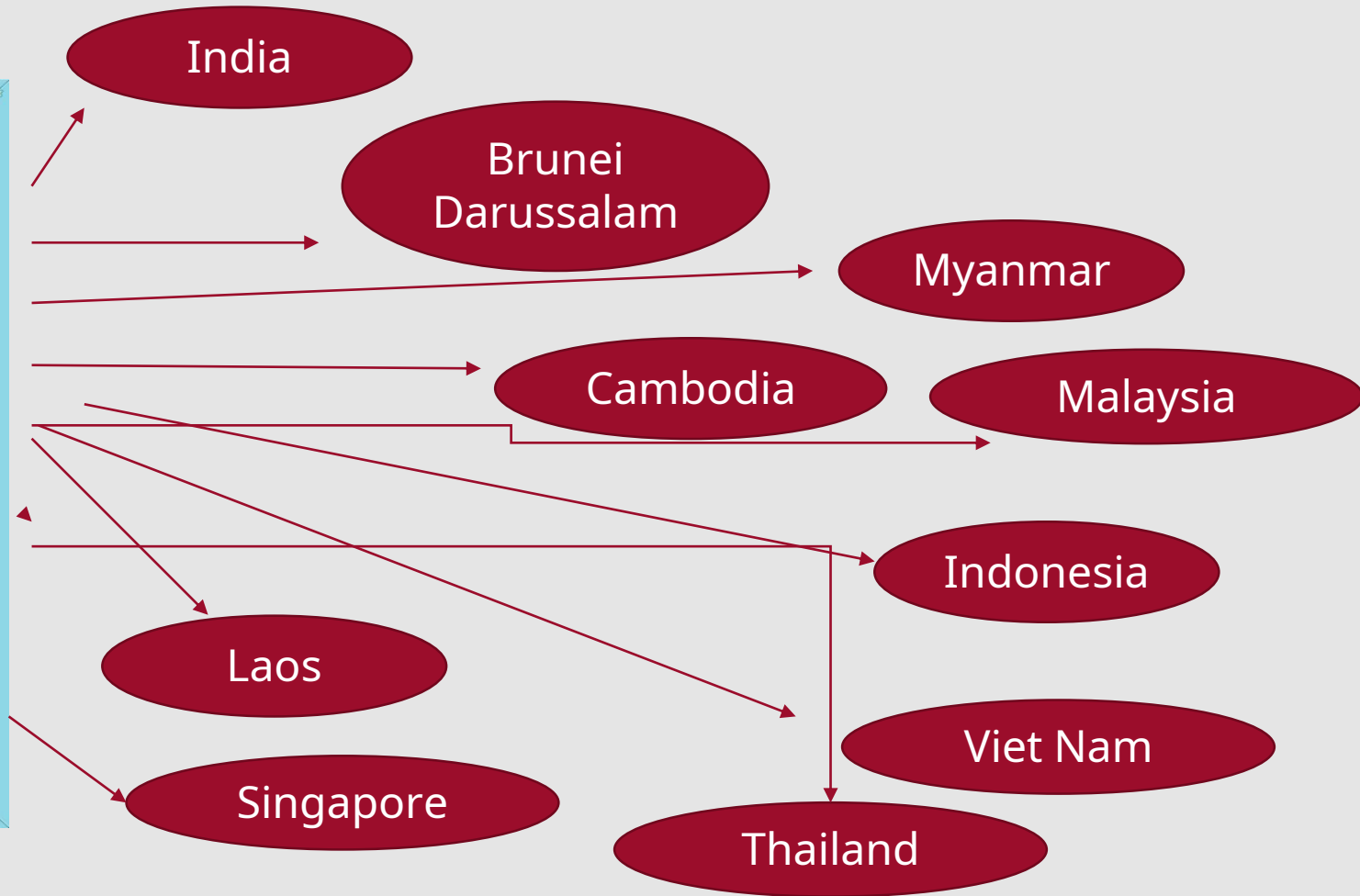

GENERAL FTA REQUIREMENTS

- FTA requirements:
 - country of origin (rules of origin)
 - direct transshipment
 - proof of origin



DUTY ANALYSIS INCLUDES INFORMATION ABOUT

- Importing country's MFN duty
- Overview of importing country's FTA's
- Preference duty/FTA duty
- Rules of origin according to the FTA
- Proof of origin according to the FTA



EXAMPLE OF DUTY ANALYSIS

Specific product x:

Country of origin Importing country	Phillippines	Laos	India	China
Japan	MFN: 5% ASEAN-Japan: 0%	MFN: 5% ASEAN-Japan: 0%	MFN: 5% India- Japan: 0%	MFN: 5% No FTA

Country of origin Importing country	Japan
Thailand	MFN: 10% ASEAN-Japan: 0%
China	MFN: 10% No FTA
Indonesia	MFN: 10% ASEAN-Japan: 5%
